PURPOSE

To acquire, lease, receive, accept, develop, manage, encumber, assign, sell, transfer and convey real property to be administered for charitable purposes on behalf of the University of North Georgia.

ABOUT

The University of North Georgia Real Estate Foundation, Inc., also referred to as the UNG REF, serves as the institution's non-exclusive facilitator and holder of leases, real estate assets, and public-private capital projects. The UNG REF is responsible for providing the institution with reports of external audits of their income and disbursement. UNG REF audits are attached to the institutions Annual Financial Report and submitted to the University System of Georgia. The UNG Real Estate Foundation has an independent board. The University of North Georgia Real Estate Foundation is a legally separate, tax exempt organization whose activities primarily support University of North Georgia by serving as the institution's facilitator and holder of public-private capital projects. University of North Georgia Real Estate Foundation has been determined significant to the State of Georgia for the past few years; therefore, the UNG REF's financial statements are not included in the University of North Georgia's annual financial statements, but instead are reported as a component unit in the Comprehensive Annual Financial Report of the State of Georgia (CAFR).

Choice St. Art Complex

ADDRESS

85 S. Chestatee, 199 Choice Ave., Dahlonega, GA 30597

ABOUT

The Choice St. Arts Complex was acquired on July 30, 2012 and renovated by the UNG Real Estate Foundation. It was later gifted to the Board of Regents on December 23, 2015. This property hosts art classrooms for weaving, film, and ceramics, as well as clinic space for the Department of Clinical Mental Health Counseling.



Blue Ridge Land

ABOUT

In August 2018, the UNG Real Estate Foundation facilitated the purchase of 10 acres of undeveloped land in Fannin County by contributing \$91,000 of the \$591,000 purchase price. The land was used to establish the UNG Blue Ridge Campus, and contains an approximately 12,000 sq. ft. academic building.


Oakwood Testing Center

ABOUT

The Oakwood Testing Center property was first leased by the UNG Real Estate Foundation from Selig Enterprises, Inc. on June 10, 2015. Following construction, this property, consisting of 3,266 square feet, was opened in October 2015. This building is used as the Testing Center for the UNG Gainesville Campus.



4th Floor Cumming City Hall

ABOUT

The 4th Floor of Cumming City Hall was first leased by the UNG Real Estate Foundation from the City of Cumming on October 14, 2015. Following construction, this property, consisting of 10,304 square feet, opened in January 2016. This space serves as an extension of the UNG Cumming Campus and houses the UNG MBA program and Continuing Education.

The Bus Barn property was acquired by the UNG Real Estate Foundation in February 2016. The building was renovated for use by Nighthawk Athletics. The property was improved to provide 136 new parking spaces and a baseball/softball/ golf training facility has been developed in a former garage structure.

ABOUT

The "Collin's House" property was acquired on May 27, 2015, and renovated in August 2015 by the UNG Real Estate Foundation. The building located on this 0.86 acre property serves as housing for UNG faculty and staff, and shares a boundary with the Barlow Road property. This property features future housing and/or commercial development opportunities.



Haney Road Property

The Haney Road property was acquired on March 5, 2014 from the UNG Foundation. This 1.24 acre property serves as consideration for future development.



Calhoun Road Property

The Calhoun Road property was donated by Bill Hardman to the UNG Real Estate Foundation in September 2011. This property, consisting of 1.25 acres, is reserved for future development.



Barlow Road Parking Lot

ABOUT

The Barlow Road Parking Lot property was acquired as town homes by the UNG Real Estate Foundation in September 2010. This property was converted to a parking lot in 2015 and consists of 70 parking spaces for commuter students and athletics. This property is adjacent to the REF owned 909 Morrison Moore Parkway property.



Radar Ridge Property

ABOUT

Radar Ridge consists of 112.48 acres of undeveloped forest land. Ownership of this wooded property was conveyed to the University, and it serves as consideration for future development. This wooded property is currently being used by the UNG Corps of Cadets for land navigation training.



Church Street House

ABOUT

The Church Street House was acquired by the University of North Georgia Real Estate Foundation in August 2018. The 0.73 acre property contains a 5,300 sq. ft. building that houses 2,100 sq. ft. retail space, a 3 bedroom apartment, and 2,000 sq. ft. space for Parking Services. The parcel is adjacent to the UNG campus and is located between existing University buildings. This property features a site that is excellent for future UNG or other development.



Tumbling Creek Research & Recreation

The Tumbling Creek property was acquired in August 2019 from the UNG Foundation. The 72 acre property is used primarily for academic purposes, with priorities for instruction, research, and also for recreational uses.

The Downtown Office Building, formerly known as the BB&T Building, was acquired by the UNG Real Estate Foundation in February 2007. This building houses the UNG Business Office, Human Resources, University Advancement, and University Press.



Church Street Deck & Recreation Center

ABOUT

The Church Street Parking Deck and Recreation Center opened in October 2008. This 267,878 square foot building houses both the UNG Rec Center and a 586 space parking deck open to commuter students. In addition to serving UNG students, the UNG Rec Center is open to faculty, staff, alumni, and community members with a paid membership.



South Deck

ABOUT

The South Deck was opened in August 2017 and provides 526 parking spaces for resident students and additional parking for the Convocation Center. If demand increases, two additional levels can be added to this parking structure.



Waters & West Main Street Parking Lot

ABOUT

The Waters and West Main Street Parking Lot was acquired by the UNG Real Estate Foundation on June 2, 2014. This lot contains 45 recently resurfaced spaces, which is leased by a local business and also used for university employee parking beside the Downtown Office Building.

ABOUT

The Waters and Warwick Street Parking Lot was acquired by the UNG Real Estate Foundation in June 2014. This lot contains 43 spaces and is used for free public parking, courtesy of the university.

The Chestatee Building property was gifted to the UNG REF in December 2009, and the building was opened in August 2011. The Chestatee Building houses Administrative Offices and a Starbucks coffee shop, which are leased. The building also includes retail store space that is fully licensed.



Gaillard Hall

ABOUT

Gaillard Hall, as the oldest of the three barracks for the UNG Corps of Cadets, was fully constructed and opened in 1956. This 48,000 square foot suite-style residence hall was renovated in September 2012 and hosts 166 beds for the UNG Corps of Cadets.



Liberty Hall

ABOUT

Liberty Hall, as the newest of three barracks for the UNG Corps of Cadets, was opened in December 2011. This 65,343 square foot suite-style residence hall hosts 262 beds for the UNG Corps of Cadets.

ABOUT

Patriot Hall, as the second newest of three barracks for the UNG Corps of Cadets, was opened in August 2010. The building consists of 87,124 square feet. This suite-style residence hall hosts 352 beds for the UNG Corps of Cadets.



The UNG Oconee campus was acquired during the merge of North Georgia College & State University and Gainesville State College in January 2013, and contains academic classrooms and office space. This property was transferred to UNG in 2023.



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
